Hanging planters donated by Bill and Brenda Loving brought back a sense of pride, life, and love as guests arrived at the clubhouse. Rodent control has made some headway both in the shed and on the grounds. We are still seeking volunteers to become involved with the management of the Island, committees, and overall administration of our community.
