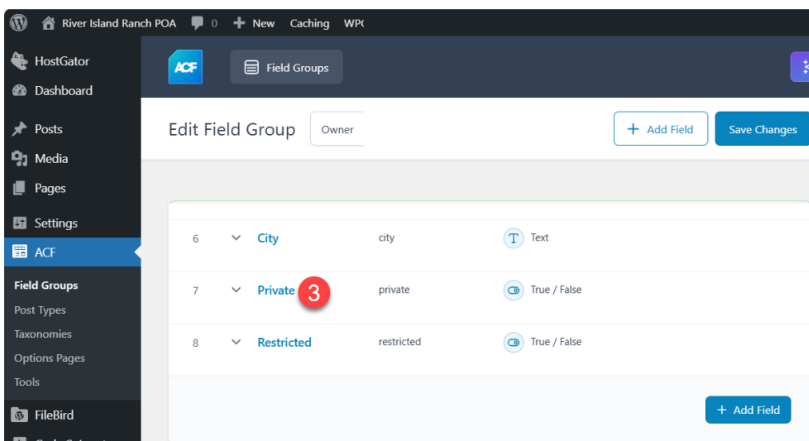
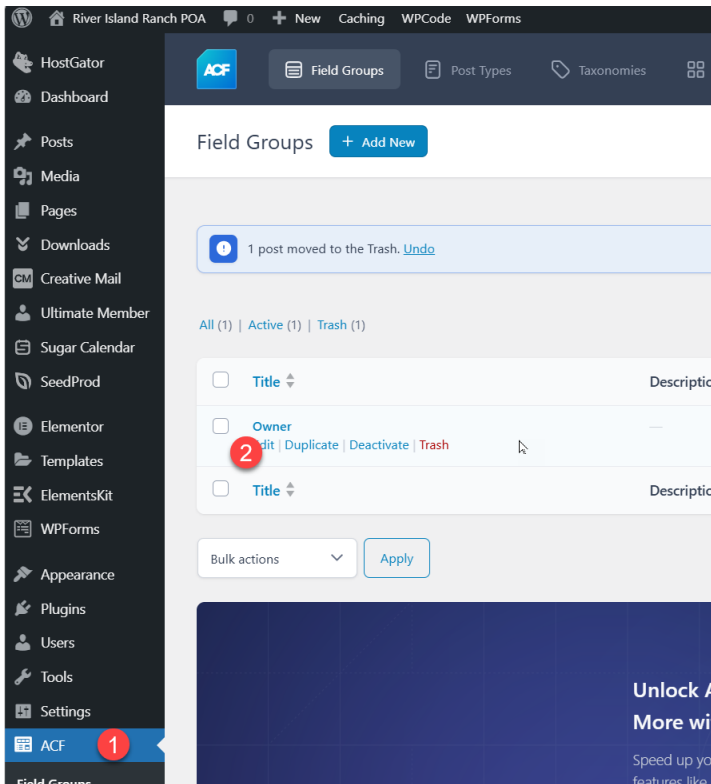


Custom Fields and Changing Profile Fields

Custom Fields

Before a field can be used in a profile, it must be added to the database. This is done using an AddIn called ACF (Add Custom Field). In general, when adding a new field, choose TextBox. It takes a simple string.
