RIR BOD UPDATE: March 4th meeting.

This will allow for a vacancy in the board to be filled by an election of candidates at our annual members meeting in August. We appreciate all members who are willing to volunteer and participate in the administration of our neighborhood. Septic System Update:

We have approved an estimate and bid from Weavers' Level Best to replace the split two piece original 1500 gallon septic tank. Static ground water pressure from river flooding has compromised the septic tank in the past and forced closure of the Island. They will replace the two piece tank with a contemporary one piece poured concrete tank. This is projected to correct the ground water from flooding the system. The cost will be \$9100.00

Our fiscal state of the Island remains healthy amid the volatility of the markets, and our stable CD and money market reserves continue to grow. The septic repair was anticipated and was present in our 2025 budget. Our tax assessment has been reviewed and restored to previous classification and will change back for tax year 2025. By most accounts, our annual assessment dues have been collected, deposited and reside in our Community Bank of Colorado account. We will be sending invoices for all filing two members water rights assessments April 1st, for the remainder of the year.

Priority action was given to our road maintenance, Island Committee improvements and clubhouse improvements at our March 4th board of directors meeting. Anyone wishing to contribute to either committee may contact any board member. We hope to invest in more outdoor furniture for the decks, new carpeting and landscaping improvements prior to the summer season. Signage was included in a discussion of improvements as well.
